## Colorado police arrest man who sent Boynton detective child pornography

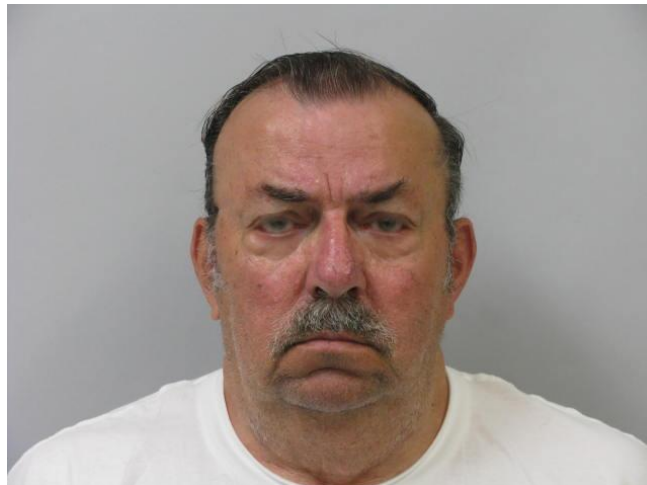
Ronald Duane Huffman didn't know he emailed child pornography to an undercover Boynton Beach detective.

He found out Tuesday morning when police in Colorado Springs knocked on his door with a search warrant.

Huffman, who turned 70 years old today, went by the Yahoo moniker sgrewballs2001. He started instant messaging Boynton Beach Detective Charles Ramos in June. Huffman emailed Ramos nine sexually explicit photos of children. He also emailed a pornographic video involving a child between the ages of 9 and 11.

Ramos contacted investigators with the Colorado Springs Police Department's Internet Crimes Against Children Unit, who along with the FBI, ICE and the El Paso County Sheriff's Office, took Huffman into custody. The Boynton Beach Police Department thanks them for their assistance in this case.

Huffman was charged with sexual exploitation of children, a third-degree felony, and was taken to the El Paso County Criminal Justice Center.
