Police investigate shooting that killed one, critically injured another

Boynton Beach police are investigating a shooting Monday night that left one man dead and another in critical condition.

Police received a call around 10:30 p.m. that a Lincoln Navigator hit a house in the 2000 block of Northeast Third Street. When officers arrived, they found the driver was incoherent and appeared to have a gunshot wound to the chest.

The man, identified as Benton Lineau, 23, of 215 N.E. 9th Ave., Boynton Beach, was taken to Delray Trauma Center, where he died.

Police then received a call from Bethesda Memorial Hospital that a man who had been shot multiple times had just been dropped off at the emergency room by someone driving a 1997 beige four-door Toyota.

That man, identified as Dieuny Pasius, 19, of 301 Ocean Parkway, Boynton Beach, was transported to Delray Trauma Center where he is in critical condition.

Witnesses told police that they heard multiple gunshots coming from the 2000 block of Northeast Third Street. Police are looking into several motives for the shooting.
