Police need help identifying motorcyclist who robbed man at ATM

Boynton Beach Police are asking for the public's help identifying a motorcyclist who robbed a man at knifepoint on Thursday afternoon at an ATM outside the Bank of America at 114 N. Federal Highway. The 47-year-old victim told police that he was depositing money into the ATM around 5 p.m. when he was approached by a man in his mid 20's who displayed a knife and said, "why don't you give me the rest of your money before I slash you with my knife."

The suspect, who was wearing a motorcycle helmet, a black jacket and black pants, took the victim's wallet and took off on a sports-type motorcycle. There was a passenger on the motorcycle who was possibly a woman dressed in all black clothing.
