On the 1st day of May 20 10 at 03:32 A.M. P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

Boynton Beach PD units responded to the 7-11 convenience store at 7044 Lawrence Road Boynton Beach, FL in reference to a 911 call received from one of the clerks (Mohamid Noor) stating Armed Robbery had just occurred at this location. The other clerk, B/M Onel Barthelemy, had been shot in the back during this Armed Robbery. Review of the video surveillance from this store showed a single subject entering the store wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, green camouflage shorts, and black high-top shoes entering the store brandishing a firearm. Barthelemy runs upon encountering this subject and is shot at this time. The subject then exits the store but immediately re-enters followed by two other subject with one wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and red shorts while the other was wearing a black shirt pulled over his face and black shorts. All three subjects proceeded to rob the store by forcing Noor to open the register. All three subjects exit the store and leave by unknown means and unknown direction. Barthelemy was subsequently transported to Delray Medical _____

On this same day at approximately 0432 hrs Jupiter PD responded to an Armed Robbery at the Circle K located at 815 West Indiantown Road Jupiter, FL where review of video surveillance showed three subjects wearing the exact same clothing as the robbery in Boynton Beach, FL. The MO was also very similar down to apparently the use of the same firearms. No person was shot during this incident. The three subjects also left in an unknown direction by unknown means.

On this same day at approximately 0515 hrs Stuart PD encountered an in-progress Armed Robbery at the RaceTrac 1755 N Federal Highway Stuart, FL where one of the police officers exchanged gun fire with two suspects at the scene. No Officer or suspect was apparently injured during the gunfire exchange. Interview with the police officer by Stuart Detectives and review of the RaceTrac video showed three suspects entering the store with hooded sweatshirts. One suspect was wearing a black hooded sweatshirts, green camouflage shorts, and black high-top sneakers. The second suspect was also wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and red shorts with the third suspect wearing a black shirt pulled over his face and black shorts. This is the exact same physical and clothing description seen in the other two robberies. At approximately 0910 hours, Stuart Police and Martin County SO apprehended B/M Luke Bowen (05/12/89), who was wearing the green camouflage shorts and B/M Reginald Gibson (04/02/87), who was wearing red shorts. A black Springfield Armory XD-40 .40 Caliber pistol (S/N US269218) and an AMT "Back Up" .380 caliber/9mm Kruz (S/N A23529) pistol were recovered during this apprehension. These firearms fit the description of the ones used in these robberies.



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
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Gibson and Bowen were interviewed Post-Miranda at Stuart Police Department where they both gave independent confessions detailing their activities during all three robberies. Both suspects also described the third person as street name 'Black', a skinny black male, 18-19 years of age, short black hair and living off of 10th Street in West Palm Beach, FL. They also stated they were using a crew cab style Ford Pick-up, possibly black in color, to commit the different robberies. Bowen also admitted to shooting Barthelemy during the Boynton Beach robbery because the gun he was using had a soft trigger.

An anonymous tip to Crimestoppers advised that there had been four suspects involved in these robberies, and that only two were in custody giving the names Trigger and Reggie. The other two (one by the name of Jay) were in West Palm Beach occupying a white Ford truck crew cab. None of this information had been released to the media. This information was also corroborated by a witness in Boynton Beach who advised that at the time of the robbery in Boynton Beach, they saw a white crew cab truck parked near her home and left just before police had arrived. West Palm Beach Police Department located and stopped a white Ford truck crew cab truck with a punched steering column a bearing Florida tag N913MA. The truck was occupied by three black males with two identified as B/M Jason Louis DOB 02/27/1991 and B/M Jartarus Walker DOB 04/14/1987.

Louis fit the description of 'Black' as provided by Gibson and Bowen. He was also wearing black shorts, black socks with NBA emblems, and black Reebok tennis shoes as can be seen in the video surveillance. Louis also confessed to his involvement to these robberies during the video-taped interviews. He identified Gibson as 'Reggie' and Bowen as 'Trigga Happy' and the roles each suspect had during the robberies. He also identified Walker as the driver during the robberies. Walker also provided an independent confession during the recorded interview where he explained his role as the driver during the three robberies. He provided corroborated statements during this interview.


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Based on the above facts there is probable cause to charge both JASON LOUIS and JARTARUS WALKER as principals for the following crimes that occurred in Boynton Beach, FL.

AGGRAVATED BATTERY WITH A FIREARM (PRINCIPAL) Both LOUIS and WALKER participated as principals when the victim Onel Barthelemy was shot with a firearm, and further during the course of committing or attempting to commit any offense listed in Florida Statute 775.087(2)(a)1, LOUIS and WALKER participated as principals when a firearm was discharged as defined in section 790.001, Florida Statutes, and, as the result of the discharge, death or great bodily harm was inflicted upon Onel Barthelemy, contrary to Florida Statutes 775.087(2)(a)1, 775.087(2)(a)2, 775.087(2)(a)3, 784.045(1)(a)1 and 2.

JASON LOUIS and JARTARUS WALKER also participated for the crime of Robbery with a Firearm as a Principal in the First Degree. They knowingly and intentionally assist in the taking of money in the custody of Onel Barthelemy with the intent to permanently or temporarily deprive ~~Barthelemy~~ of the money and in the course of the committing the robbery did carry a firearm contrary to FSS 812.13(2a).
