Police investigating armed robbery, searching for third suspect

Boynton Beach police are searching for the third suspect involved in an armed robbery Monday night at a Bank of America ATM on North Congress Avenue.

Just before 10 p.m., a 65-year-old woman was attempting to make a deposit when she was approached from behind by two males, one of whom pointed a silver handgun at her and demanded her money.

The man then grabbed at her deposit envelope, which contained cash and checks.

The woman struggled with the man, who fled on foot without getting the money.

Officers set up a perimeter and found one of the suspect's in an apartment on Stonehaven Drive in Banyan Lakes.

Inside, they found Darvin Pickett, who was wearing the same orange shirt and dark blue jeans the victim described her attacker wearing.

Pickett, 18, was charged with robbery with a firearm, assault, battery on a law enforcement officer and resisting arrest. He remains in the Palm Beach County Jail.

Another suspect, Jetro Louis, was found concealing himself behind an apartment building in Banyan Lakes. Louis, 18, was charged with robbery with a firearm and resisting arrest without violence.

Police are looking for a third man who committed the robbery. Bank surveillance photos (pictured above) show he was wearing a black shirt and black mask.
