One injured in early morning shooting

A 23-year-old Boynton Beach man is in critical but stable condition after he was shot in the back this morning in front of his house on Northeast First Street.

Arcenio Price of Boynton Beach was sitting in front of the house with Donald Barbary, 21, of Lake Worth when a white vehicle drove by.

A few minutes later, the same vehicle pulled up in front of the men and a black male wearing a black shirt over his face exited the passenger's side of the car. He pointed a handgun at Price and Barbary and told them not to run.

Price and Barbary ran in different directions. Price was shot once in the back. Barbary was not injured. Price was taken to Delray Trauma Center where he remains in critical condition.
