On the 22 day of April 20 10 at 11:44 A.M. P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

I responded to 1035 W Gateway Blvd BB, FL (parking lot of Boca Tanning) in reference to a report of an individual lying with their head on the steering wheel. BBPD dispatch also advised the vehicle which was described as a Blue Honda had been running for approximately twenty minutes.

Upon arrival the 07 Honda bearing FL tag G043XC was located in the parking in the parking lot. It is to be noted there was only one other vehicle in the parking lot at the time of arrival (was a black Altima). Officers Baldino approached the driver's side of the vehicle which was still running and observed W/F Lobig, Jessica (DOB 9/28/85) sweating profusely and slumped over with a plastic pipe in her mouth and a piece of tin foil with burn marks on her lap. A W/M (juvenile/Lobig's child) (DOB 11/21/07) was located in the back seat and was also sweating profusely. Ofc Baldino knocked on the vehicle's window numerous times in attempt to wake Lobig which met with negative results. Ofc Baldino proceeded to open the vehicle door to check to see if Lobig was still breathing or in need of medical assistance. After opening the vehicle door and she awoke. Ofc Baldino attempted to assess Lobig's condition at which point she spontaneously uttered she was 'smoking blues' referring to smoking prescription medication. Lobig advised she did not need medical assistance and was read her Miranda Warning. A DUI investigation was conducted and Lobig was arrested (see Ofc Monteith's report).

After being advised Lobig understood her Miranda Warning she stated she had come from an AA meeting in West Palm Beach. After attending the meeting she stopped at her boyfriend's house. After leaving her boyfriend's (NOI) residence began to cry and she pulled into the parking lot to change his diaper. She then got a phone call and began arguing with her boyfriend and was not smoking Roxy's in the vehicle.

Inventory of the vehicle revealed a prescription bottle of different pills with no discernible label which contained Xanax 2mg schedule IV substance x13, Roxycodone 30mg schedule II x4, Oxycodone 15mg schedule II x1 (all confirmed by poison control ID 726), another medicine bottle with a green leafy substance from my training and experience to be marijuana, another glass pipe (blue) which contained remnants of burnt marijuana and multiple pieces of burned tin foil (one with a pill still attached). Lobig was additionally being charged with Child Neglect F.S.S. 827.03(3)(c), Transportation of Paraphernalia F.S.S. 893.147(4)(b), Possession of Marijuana under 20 Grams F.S.S. 893.13(6)(b) (3.2 grams net), Poss of Controlled Substance w/o F.S.S. 893.13(6)(A)

*****SUPPLEMENTAL PC*****

I responded to 1035 W. Gateway Blvd. in reference to a CLS call. While en route dispatch advised that a female was unconscious in a blue Honda pick up truck with her head down on the steering wheel for the last 20 minutes.

Upon my arrival I observed a vehicle matching the description given by dispatch (Blue in color 2007 Honda Ridgeline pickup truck bearing FL tag G043XC). While approaching the running vehicle, I observed a white female (later identified as Lobig, Jessica (DOB 9/28/1985) hunched over with her face down in her chest, as I got to said vehicle I observed a child [redacted] DOB 11/21/2007) in a car seat on the rear passenger side possibly asleep. I knocked numerous times on the driver side window attempting to wake the occupants of the vehicle in order to check on their welfare, however I was met with negative results. I then checked the driver side door handle and found the door to be unlocked. It should be noted that as soon as I opened the driver side door, smoke bellowed out into the air and in plain view I observed a purple in color plastic straw still in Lobig's mouth, and tin foil on her lap with fresh black burn/ streak marks and a lighter underneath the tinfoil. I know from my training and experience that this drug paraphernalia is commonly used to free base (smoke) prescription pills. I asked Lobig if she was having a medical emergency and she stated "no". I asked Lobig what she was doing and she spontaneously uttered "smoking blue's" (blue's is a street term for roxycodone)

The case was then turned over to Ofc. Monteith and Ofc. Monroe.
