

On the 22 day of August 2010 at 02:00  A.M.  P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

BBPD marked units responded to the area of 8100 Mahogany Dr Boynton Beach, FL in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival Ofc Rini observed a W/M later identified as GREG SENSER DOB 05/12/1981 standing in the apartment building hallway on the ground floor and in close proximity to the victim B/M Jason Barnett DOB 07/24/1981. SENSER immediately took off running upon seeing Ofc Rini in his police uniform. Ofc Rini gave chase while identifying himself as a police officer and calling out to SENSER to stop. Ofc Rini lost sight of SENSER when he jumped over a fence into another community development. While Ofc Rini was chasing SENSER other Officers were providing medical aid to Barnett who had contusion to his face and a deep, long laceration to the neck. When Ofc Rini found SENSER he was completely wet at which time SENSER spontaneously uttered, "I jumped in the lake." He was taken into custody and brought back to the scene where other Officers were still providing medical aid to Barnett. SENSER could see the victim and the other Officers providing the aid where he began making more spontaneous utterances to include, "This dude set me up. I didn't mean for the guy to die. We had a struggle. I cut him. I cut his neck. I did it. I used a pocket knife from my truck after he set me up and his friends shot at me." After BBFD arrived and transported the victim to Delray Medical Hospital where he was pronounced dead at approximately 0240 hrs. SENSER was transported to BBPD for questioning.

The hallway crime scene showed small BLS droplets beginning near the open hallway at the north side of the three story apartment building. Several feet south along the hallway that runs in the same direction is a large stains and pools of BLS on the ground along with blood spatter on the east wall approximately one foot from the ground. No weapon was found at this scene other than a small pocket knife belonging to one of the officers that was providing aid to the victim.

Detective Diaz and CSI McKinlay responded to the hospital where CSI McKinlay photographed the victim and collected personal belongings and clothing. Det Diaz met with Trauma Dr Parra who stated the victims eyes were swollen shut. The laceration to the throat area was deep as can be clearly seen in the photographs and is at least six inches in length. It should be noted the defendant is approximately 6'05" with a large muscular build while the victim is approximately 6'0" with a lean build.

At approximately 0500 hrs Ofc Wilmar Rodriguez was standing by with SENSER who began speaking to Ofc Rodriguez. Ofc Rodriguez read SENSER his Miranda Warnings that he acknowledged and signed the card. SENSER began telling Ofc Rodriguez what had occurred during this incident.



The following is a summary and not a verbatim account of his digitally video recorded statements. SENSER has known the victim for quite some time and is good friends with his brother. SENSER ingested powder cocaine earlier in the evening while with victim, Barnett. This made him a little paranoid and he became uneasy while they were at the bar. They left the bar and feels Barnett became upset about this. They arrived at an apartment building where the incident occurred. An argument ensued between them at which time the victim reportedly punched SENSER. SENSER at this time punched Barnett dropping to the ground. Vic Barnett got up and SENSER punched him again causing Barnett to fall once more. Barnett at this time reportedly gets up holding a knife in his hand attempts to stab SENSER several times. Barnett reportedly states before trying to stab SENSER, "You better kill me or I'm going to kill you and your family." SENSER says he 'loses it' and begins wrestling with Barnett at which time SENSER gains control of the knife while they are on the ground. SENSER is on top of the victim who has his back on the ground, holds the victim and begins stabbing him. SENSER reportedly blacks out during this time but remembers fleeing from Officer he sees coming towards him. He remembers jumping in the canal and being spotted by the police again and complies at this time. Injuries to the neck area are indicative the victim was stabbed numerous times around this region. When confronted about threats to his family SENSER states he has no family here in the Florida region but in other states to include Ohio. SENSER also claims he did not know where he disposed the knife since he had apparently 'blacked out' during this time. However he remembers seeing the Officer(s) coming towards him and being on top of the victim while he stabbed him. Based on these facts there is probable cause to charge SENSER with the following crime. SECOND DEGREE MURDER did unlawfully kill victim Barnett, a human being, by stabbing him, said act being imminently dangerous to another and evincing a depraved mind regardless of human life, although without any premeditated design to effect the death of any particular individual, contrary to Florida Statute 782.04(2).
