

(Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p> <p>On 02/03/2010 at 2104, BBPD responded to Snappers Seafood Restaurant located at 398 North Congress Avenue in Boynton Beach, Florida in reference to a strong arm robbery. Victim reported that she was walking in the parking lot when a white male on a bicycle traveled eastbound and ripped her purse from her hands. The suspect then proceeded eastbound on Old Boynton Road.</p> <p>On 02/08/2010, I spoke with the victim who told me that several days earlier she received a call from a female named Tania Kaufman who lives at 1250 Old Boynton Road #303. Kaufman told the victim that she had found the purse and wanted to get it back to the victim. The victim went to Kaufman's residence and retrieved the purse and all belongings except the \$250.00 in currency.</p> <p>On 02/08/2010, I met with Kaufman who told me that she lived with her boyfriend Lester Gibb. Kaufman told me that she found the purse on the roadway and gave it back to the victim. While at the residence I noticed a silver bicycle on the patio. Kaufman then told me that Gibb has not been around too much in the last few days.</p> <p>On 02/09/2010, I went back to 1250 Old Boynton Road #303 and met with Kaufman who quickly told me that she had not been truthful when we spoke on 02/08/2010 and that Gibb was responsible for the robbery. Kaufman invited me inside the residence, where I met with Lester Gibb in the bedroom. I told Gibb that we needed to talk, and he quickly said "I wasn't at Snapper's the other night". Gibb followed it up by saying "there is no way that her fingers got broken". Based on this information, Gibb was brought to BBPD for further investigation. Kaufman also came to BBPD, where she gave a sworn audio statement and said only minutes after the time of the robbery, Gibb came into their residence "panting and out of breath". Gibb had been riding the silver bicycle as he arrived home. It should be noted that Snapper's is approximately 200 yards from the Gibb's residence. Gibb told Kaufman everything was ok and she went to bed. The next morning, Kaufman found a woman's purse in the kitchen with the belongings of the victim. Kaufman confronted Gibb and Gibb admitted that he stole the purse. Kaufman told Gibb that she was going to contact the owner of the purse and Gibb told her not to because he was going to get into trouble. As a result, Kaufman did contact the victim and return the purse. Gibb would not give a statement, but would only say that Kaufman found the purse on the roadway.</p> <p>It should be noted that the victim has suffered from two fractured fingers from the force of the robbery. Based on the above, I find probable cause to charge Gibb with one count of strong arm robbery pursuant to FSS 812.13. He was processed and turned over to PBCJ.</p>
