The undersigned certifies and swears that he/she has just and reasonable grounds to believe, and does believe that the above named Defendant committed the following violation of law. The Person taken into custody... On the 17 day of March 20 10 at 7:19 A.M.

On the above date and time I responded to 511 NE 4th ST, in reference to a subject calling 911 emergency line several times, yelling at dispatch using profanity in reference to obtaining the status on a "fake" bartender from a bar he was at previously (Benny Ice House / 9803 S. Military Tr. Boynton Beach FL). It was advised by dispatch that the subject later identified as (Kanhai, Guavin) called the 911 emergency line and spoke with the call takers who advised Kanhai that he did not have an emergency and advised him to contact the non emergency number (561-742-6035) at then end of the first 911 call

A few seconds later Kanhai called the 911 emergency line a second time, disregarding what he was advised by the call takers on the previous call again began requesting the status of a female bartender from Benny Ice House. The call taker again advised Kanhai that his call was not an emergency, and urged him to call the non emergency line.

Disregarding the first two warnings Kanhai then called the 911 emergency line a third and final time speaking incoherently with slurred speech and profanity towards the call taker requesting the same information as advised prior, regarding the bartenders status. It should be noted that the incident regarding the bartender and Kanhai occurred outside of BBPD jurisdiction. It was at this time that the BBPD call takers dispatched the call to the BBPD units to make contact with the subject in reference to the false 911 calls.

Upon my arrival I met with Kanhai who stated he called 911 to find out the status of a "fake" bartender that worked at Benny Ice House. While speaking with Kanhai I noticed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage immersing from his breath and person. While speaking with Kanhai he was unable to communicate with me due to the fact he was highly intoxicated, but spontaneously uttered that there was no emergency and just wanted information about the bartender from Benny Ice House. I then advised Kanhai that he has falsely used the emergency 911 line by calling in reference to an incident that did not require a 911 emergency response from BBPD officers.

Based on the above circumstances Kanhai was found to have improperly used the 911 emergency line and was placed under arrest per (FSS 365.172 (13) . Kanhai was transported to BBPD for processing and later TOT PBCJ.
