MISSING ADULT



Search continues for missing Boynton woman

Take a long look at the woman pictured here. Her name is Tina Lurie. And she disappeared exactly one year ago today.

Lurie, 38, was last seen around 8 p.m. on March 29, 2009 when she left her home on Old Boynton Road and reportedly walked across the street to go to Super Target. She never returned to the Poinciana West condo she shared with her boyfriend.

Boynton Beach police reviewed surveillance video from the Super Target at 650 N. Congress Ave., but did not see any footage of Lurie entering or exiting the store. She also was not seen on surveillance video from any surrounding stores or areas.

Lurie suffers from bi-polar disorder and does not have medication with her. She also has a history of alcohol abuse.

Neither Lurie's parents nor boyfriend have heard from her.

Boynton Beach Police are urging you to come forward if you have any information as to Lurie's whereabouts. You can remain anonymous.
